Anthony Davidson "Chief Spirit Hawk", 56, of Summerville, husband of Wanda Ward Davidson, passed away Saturday, September 26, 2015 at Heartland Healthcare of Charleston.

Family and friends are invited to attend a visitation on Tuesday, September 29, 2015 from 6 to 8 o'clock at James A. Dyal Funeral Home. Mr. Davidson was born January 4, 1959 in Ridgeville, son of Eugene Davidson of Ridgeville and the late Geneva Sweat Davidson. He was the Chief of the Edisto Tribe and known as Chief Spirit Hawk. He was proud of his heritage and who he was and always had a vision for his people. He was a very loving husband, father and grandfather. He was self-employed in construction and his company was known as Carpenter for Christ.

Survivors are his wife Wanda and one son and one daughter: Kacey Michelle Davidson of Summerville and Stephen Allen Davidson (Jenna Pein) of Summerville, six grandchildren: Noah and Gracelyn Calvert of Summerville, Mika Lee McInnis, Kira Lynette Davidson and Haleigh Joyce Pein all of
