Barbara “Bobbi” Hare Gilstrap, 66, of Summerville, wife of Wm. “Roger” Gilstrap, passed away Friday, April 23, 2021 at Summerville Medical Center.

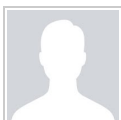

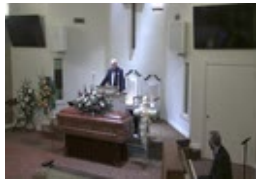
