



Barbara Ann Shetterly Mowery

September 23, 1968 - January 7, 2022

Barbara Ann Shetterly Mowery, 53, of Summerville, passed away on January 7, 2022 after a courageous three years battling ovarian cancer. Born on September 23rd, 1968 in Washington, D.C., to Russell Bond and Ann Veirs Shetterly, she was raised in Irmo as the oldest of four siblings. Barbara attended Anderson College for 2 years and received her BS in education from College of Charleston in 1991.

She met her husband of nearly 30 years, Ret Lt Cdr Walter Brian Mowery of Ramona, CA, while he was stationed in Charleston, thus beginning her adventures moving around the country as a Navy wife. Together with her husband, and sometimes apart due to deployments, Barbara found her greatest calling in raising her three children: Katherine Jones (Austin), Peyton Mowery (Anna Stewart), and Grace Ann Mowery. In addition to Summerville, Barbara and her family experienced life in Enid, OK, Pensacola, FL, Ramona, CA, Athens, GA, Bremerton, WA, and Lansing, KS. Barbara became a master road tripper and packer - she made every house a home.

Barbara was a dedicated elementary school teacher before becoming a stay at home mom for many years. She returned to work at Fort Dorchester High School in 2012 working in multiple secretary positions. At work Barbara was a well-known, awarded, and loved member of her Fort Family.

In the last year of her life, Barbara was blessed enough to become a "Bobbie" to her first granddaughter, Callahann Eliza Jones with whom she spent many silly and happy moments. While she wished for more time being a

grandmother, Barbara made countless beautiful memories that will last Callahann a lifetime.

In addition to her husband, children, and granddaughter; Barbara is survived by her parents, two siblings: Krista Parrot of Columbia, SC and Michael Shetterly of Greenville, SC; Multiple nieces and nephews, a very large and loving extended family, and many close friends. She was preceded in death by her sister Joanie Shetterly Loquist.

Barbara will be remembered for her loving and bright personality, sarcastic humor, beautiful smile and contagious laugh. She was loved by everyone who came into contact with her, she never said no to helping others, and was rarely discouraged. Barbara could do anything she put her mind to. She loved animals of every kind, watching her youngest daughter play soccer, talking with her children, reading, and looking for sharks teeth at Edisto Beach- her favorite place. She always told everyone, "you can do hard things".

Most of all, Barbara loved Jesus. Barbara loved to worship Jesus and share encouraging words with others. She was the type of person you could see Jesus through by her actions, unconditional love, and loyalty. We will continue to try our best to emulate her in the way we live our lives as we wait to see her again.

Her family would like to thank everyone who supported Barbara in her journey against cancer. In particular, Dr. Ward Katsanis and his staff, the Nurses at the Trident Cancer Center, the Teal Diva team, and her many friends and family who covered her in prayers and well wishes.
