



## Bernard "Bud" Barton

July 15, 1938 - August 11, 2024

Bernard A. "Bud" Barton of Summerville, SC, husband of Betty White Barton, passed away on Sunday, August 11, 2024.

Bud, a retired USAF MSGT, was born July 15, 1938 in Potosi, MO, the son of the late Robert Taylor and Mary Evans Barton. Bud loved playing and coaching various sports for over 50 years. He played baseball, softball, football, boxing, and swimming. He enlisted in the Air Force just after high school, and served for 23 years in Florida, South Carolina, Korea, Phillipians, Viet Nam and Germany. He served as a flight engineer for 17 years on C-124, C-118 and C-141 aircraft. Bud amassed over 8,000 flying hours and flew over 120 combat missions in Viet Nam. He was awarded four Air Medals, a Presidential Outstanding Unit Award, a Viet Nam Presidential Award, an Air Force Outstanding Unit Award, and an Air Force Commendation Award. After retiring from the Air Force, Bud worked as a professional Realtor for over 30 years where he earned many prestigious awards. Bud was a member of Old Fort Baptist Church where he served for many years.

Bud was married to Betty White Barton for 64 years. He leaves behind his loving children: Bernard Barton, Jr. (Angela Carter Barton) and Sandra Barton Dugan (Caldwell Norton Dugan, Jr.); Grandchildren: Zachary Schible (Laura), Austin Schible, Caldwell Dugan, III, Victoria Dugan Tupper (Caleb Siegel Tupper) and Rebekah Dugan; Great-Grandchildren: Selah Schible, Elliana
