Billy Jack Iserman, known as "Bill" or "BJ" was born in Dayton, Ohio in 1930. He attended Brown Elementary, Fairview High and also Bowling Green State University, University of Dayton and Michigan Lutheran College. After serving in the US Army Signal Corp in Korea he came home to his wife, Joanne Page, and went on to earn a Masters Degree and a Doctorate of Business Administration, and was a director/teacher of the weekend "finish your degree" program at Pacific Western University in Toronto Canada. He was Director of Professional Relations at Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Michigan and owner/CEO of a medical consulting firm.
