“ Hi McCorkle family ,my name is Victoria Campbell, and I just recently learned of your dad, Richard's, passing last year. I've become acquainted with Sarah through Facebook since late last year. I want to say how truly sorry I am for your family's loss of your Dad and can't believe you are again dealing with yet another loss..your mom. I am the same age as your dad and it is way too young to think that you have lost them both. I knew Richard, your dad, when we were both kids. We went to church and sang in the choir at Pasadena Community Methodist Church in St Petersburg, Florida. We were about 10 years old and were introduced by Richard's grandpa "Van" who decided to play matchmaker since I guess your dad had a bit of a crush on me. I'm guessing 1974? Richard is always the name I knew him by his grandparents were Mr and Mrs Vanderhooten to me and they lived in Treasure Island. Richard had lived with them for sometime but shortly after he moved to New Mexico with Charles whom I knew as his dad but over the years I came to know that his mother had passed away young and I can't remember anything about his biological father. Anyway we spent some time together before he moved with my family and his and after he moved we regularly wrote letters to each other. Each summer for years he came back to stay with his grandparents and we spent what seemed like every summer together. We fished off the dock at the house on Treasure Island. Your dad was pretty good at casting a net and catching mullet. We took out the boat and swam in the canal. We went to the beach together many times and spent 4th of July's together. We went to Disney World together with my mom and Charles. I have so many happy memories of your dad. Sometime while he was in highschool he and Charles moved to the Atlanta area. Ellenwood so was a lot closer. He spent a number of Christmases in Florida. I can remember us driving in his car. He could be pretty crazy behind the wheel. I know he joined the Coast Guard and I graduated high school in 1982 and went to college. During that time we talked from time to time. College is where I met my husband Bill. Your dad was stationed in Cape May, NJ. I got an invitation when he was married maybe around 1984? Of course being in college I couldn't go but about a year later we talked for

what I remember to be the last time. He had just had his 1st child "Richie." I was getting married the following year. I learned from my mother that both his grandparents had passed and I remember us talking about that. At that point we lost touch. His grandparents were gone, there were no cell phones or social media. I moved to New Hampshire just after I was married in 1986 and back to Florida in 1990. In 2006, my family which now also included 3 children moved to Warner Robins, GA just south of Macon. Since the advent of social media, I've searched many times for Richard McCorkle as I knew him. There were so many and none of the pictures were right or there were no pictures. I kept hoping that I would locate him and reconnect. Sadly I knew that I had found him when googled and found his obituary. This broke my heart. I'm so sad that I will never have that chance. I confess I've done a bit of looking around Facebook at your familys' profiles I reached out to Sarah and shared a few photos of us . I was so happy to learn that he had 5 beautiful children & 2 grandchildren. I finally found his profile as Rick Sr. I was so happy to learn that he had been very happily married for so many years. I'd so hope to meet your mother one day And I was crushed when I saw Sarah's post that she had just passed away. Although I'm sure there is much that I have missed it looks like your mother and father were very very Happy together . And my prayer and hope is that as she move forward you will endeavor to remember that happiness and that joy . I know having lost my mother early but sometimes it's hard to focus on anything but how much you miss them . From reading your fathers Facebook it appears that he had a very strong Christian faith and that he was living that faith out. Although we don't know one another I want you to know that your family is in my thoughts and prayers . I hope someday to meet one or all of you but even if I never get that opportunity I want you to know then I am truly sorry And that I will continue to pray for each of you That God will give you comfort and strength each day as you Move forward
