



Broadus Troy Burgess

June 11, 1920 - December 20, 2016

Retired Air Force Senior Master Sergeant Broadus Troy Burgess of Summerville, passed away on Tuesday, December 20, 2016 at Royal Oaks Senior Center in Summerville.

A memorial service will be held at James A. Dyal Funeral Home on Thursday, December 22, 2016 at 10 o'clock AM. Inurnment will be held Woodlawn Memorial Gardens in Greenville, SC at a later date with military honors.

Mr. Burgess was born on June 11, 1920 in Pacolet Mills, SC son of the late John A. Burgess and Lillie D. Burgess. He retired from the Air Force after more than 30 years of service and from Robert Bosch Corporation of Charleston. He was a veteran of WWII, the Korean and Vietnam wars and was the recipient of several awards, including the Unit Presidential Citation. He was a member of Summerville Baptist Church.
