



## Bryan Thornton LeNoir

March 23, 1969 - February 8, 2019

Bryan Thornton LeNoir, 49, of Summerville, husband of Wanda Coleman LeNoir, passed away on Friday, February 8, 2019 at Roper Hospice Cottage.
