Candice Susan Ruppert, 69, of Summerville, wife of Troy Ruppert, passed away on Monday, June 29, 2020 at Rainey Hospice House in Anderson, SC.

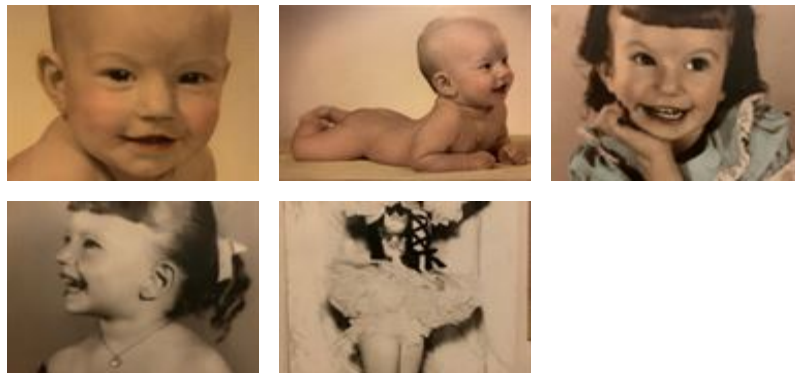
