

## Charles E. Lichtenberger

February 2, 1935 - October 23, 2021

Charles E. Lichtenberger, 86, of Summerville, husband of Lorraine Blake Lichtenberger, died peacefully surrounded by his family on October 23, 2021 at the home he shared with his wife.

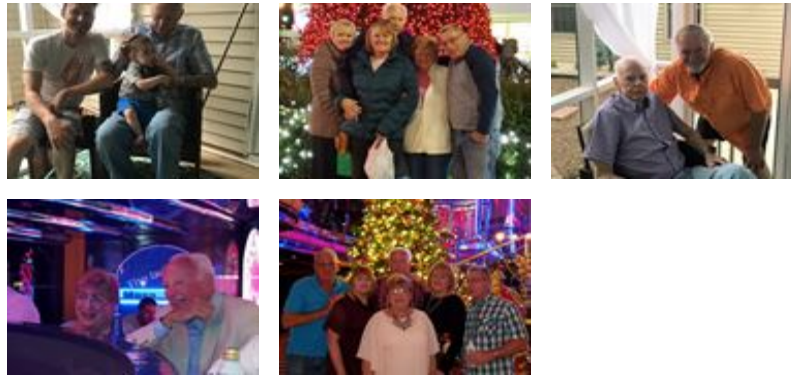

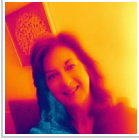

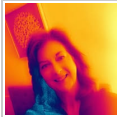
