Charles "Charlie" Owens Williams, 80, of Summerville, formerly of Williston, SC, husband of Rebekah Bannister Williams passed away peacefully on Saturday, February 13, 2016 at his residence.

Mr. Williams was born October 9, 1935 in Lexington County, SC, son of the late Rev. Avander Jerome Williams and Effie Susanna (Susan) Johnson Williams. He was a graduate of Pelion High School. Mr. Williams was employed by Savannah River Site as Supervisor at DWPF and joyfully retired in 1993. While employed, he invented a form of welding aluminum to stainless steel and was recognized in national journals. He also freelanced as an award-winning photographer for many years-photographing weddings, sporting events and for the "Williston Way" Newspaper. He was an avid Gamecocks fan and enjoyed hunting and fishing. Charles was an active member of Summerville Baptist Church previously serving as Deacon.
