Alex accomplished so much in the 23 yrs he was with us. He did it all on his own too. I am so proud of him for that.

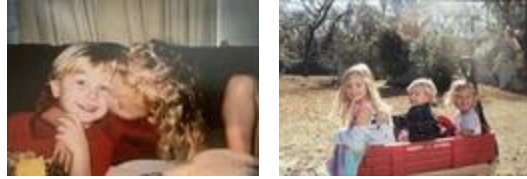
