



Dr. Corbin Isaac Miles, Jr.

February 5, 1940 - June 2, 2018

Dr. Corbin Isaac Miles, Jr., 78, of Summerville, husband of Pamela Janet Miles, passed away Saturday, June 2, 2018 at Life Care Center of Charleston.

Corbin was born February 5, 1940 in Detroit, MI, son of the late Corbin I. Miles, Sr. and Palma Chirillo Miles. Although he couldn't count or spell more than three letter words by the third grade, he went on to receive undergraduate degrees in math, chemistry and physics, and his Masters and Ph.D. in chemistry from Wayne State University. He worked his entire career at the Food and Drug Administration in Missouri, Minnesota, Michigan and Washington, DC. Corbin retired from the FDA in 1995 after a very distinguished career. He was also very active in church work, Boy Scouts, and other volunteer jobs. He was a deacon at church and was in charge of the

mission work of the church for many years. He went on evangelistic missions to Venezuela, Panama, Russia and spent a year on mission in Tanzania East Africa with Pam, going on many adventures together.
