CW5 Curtis Scott "Skinny" Reagan, 43, of Rincon, GA, former of Summerville, SC, husband of Tanna Renee (Groce) Reagan, passed away on Friday, March 29, 2013 in Afghanistan which was non-combat related.

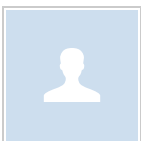

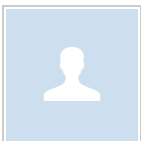

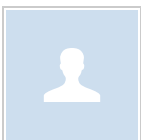
