David Blackstone, 65, of Summerville, died Friday, October 22, 2021, from injuries sustained in a multi-vehicle accident in Dorchester County, SC.

David was born July 15, 1956, in Presque Isle, Maine. He was a graduate of Bob Jones University in Greenville, SC, and he was a 40 year resident of Summerville.
