David Henry Hubert Guerin, 89, of Summerville, South Carolina, peacefully entered into eternal rest on March 26, 2026, surrounded by his loving family in his daughter's home.

Born on June 14, 1936, in Woonsocket, Rhode Island, David was the son of the late Henry Hubert Guerin and Rose Marie Guerin. David proudly served his country in both the United States Marine Corps for 10 years and the United States Air Force for 13 years. During his military career, he served around the world, including during the Korean Conflict, the Vietnam War, and the Cuban Crisis. He was honored with many military achievements including marksmanship. He earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Occupational Education from Southern Illinois. He went on to work 20 years at Trident Technical College where he pioneered the Aircraft Maintenance program beginning its curriculum in 1976. He held numerous roles, including Quality Control Inspector and Professor of Aviation Maintenance. Through his work, he influenced and mentored countless students, leaving a lasting impact. He cherished time spent with his family above all else. In his spare time, he enjoyed many home improvement projects and repair on his automobiles, going to the movies, going to the shooting range, walks in the park and breakfast at the Waffle House. He was a faithful member of St Teresa Little Flower and was a 4th degree in the Knights of Columbus. In his earlier years he was also very involved with the Shriners, Dorchester County neighborhood

crime watch.

He will be remembered for his sweet antics and his professing that “The Good Lord is Looking After me. “
