Earl Elwood Miles, 85, of Ladson, widower of Leah Leonie Monteyne Miles, passed away on Wednesday, July 3, 2013 at Veteran's Victory House in Walterboro.

A memorial service will be held on Monday, July 15, 2013 at 7 o'clock PM at James A. Dyal Funeral Home, Summerville.

Earl was born on September 26, 1927 in Syracuse, NY, son of the late Earl Ward Miles and Jean Montross Miles. He served in the United States Navy for four years and the United States Army for 16 years. He was a World War II veteran. During WWII he served on the USS Purdy DD734 as a ships cook. Upon transfer to the Army he served as a cook and baker. Later on he was accepted in US Army Counter Intelligence and served in Austria, Germany, Italy, and France. He retired at Ft. Bliss in El Paso, TX. Earl was a Shriner and a 32nd Degree Mason. He was also a licensed Horologist/Watch Maker.
