Edward A. "Ed" Tumbleston, 85, of Summerville, widower of Lurline Ulmer Tumbleston, went home to be with his Lord and Saviour on Wednesday, March 31, 2010 at the Village of Summerville.

He loved to farm and was a life member of Boonehill United Methodist Church.
