



Edward Harrison Lewin

May 21, 1920 - April 27, 2011

Lt Col. Edward Harrison Lewin, Jr., US Army Ret., 90, of Summerville, died Wednesday, April 27, 2011 at the Village at Summerville.

Funeral Mass will be held Monday, May 2, 2011 at 11 o'clock at St. John the Beloved Catholic Church, Summerville. Entombment will be held at Our Lady of Mercy Cemetery in Miami, Florida. Family requests no flowers.

Mr. Lewin was born May 21, 1920 in Boston, Massachusetts, son of the late Edward Harrison Lewin and Edith Lillian Hall Lewin. He retired as a Lieutenant Colonel after 32 years with the United States Army. He served in World War II and was a POW in the Korean Conflict. He was a survivor of the German Massacre of American Troops at Kasserine Pass in North Africa. He was an artist, enjoyed golfing, taking cruises and was a member of the Knights of Columbus.
