Ed was born in Irwin Township, Pennsylvania on January 24, 1942 to James Calvin Miller and Mabel Evangeline Benson - Miller. He was the brother of Jim Miller and Calvin Miller, and half brother to Reatha May Payne. He was the husband of Patricia Nye Miller.

Ed was the father to two biological children - Kristine Hope Lehne and Kyle Edward Miller. Ed was the father-in-law to Bill Lehne - husband to Kristine - and Wendy Miller - wife to Kyle. 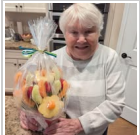
