Commander Edward Murray Redman, Jr., retired USCG passed away on Friday, December 2, 2016.

Born in Walterboro, SC on March 17, 1936 to Bessie Tumbleston Redman and Edward Murrie Redman, he was a graduate of St. Paul's High School and Clemson University. After graduating from Clemson in 1958 with a Mechanical Engineering degree, he enlisted in the Coast Guard and graduated from Officer's Candidate School as a Lt. JG.
