



Elizabeth Shader Wyckoff

December 7, 1931 - August 2, 2023

Elizabeth S. (Beth) Wyckoff died peacefully at home (The Village at Summerville) in the company of her husband Garrett Henry (Gary) Wyckoff to whom she was joyfully married since October 4, 1952. Beth was born 12/7/1931 in Orange, NJ, the daughter of Margaret Sansom and George Wilbur Shader. She and Gary raised Wendy Munce (1954-2022) (John Munce), Bonnie (John White), and Peter (Jennifer Richardson). They moved often until finding their forever home in Summerville, SC in 1972. Beth loved singing in the St. Paul's Anglican and The Village choirs until 2023 and was one of the founders of the Singers of Summerville. At age 40, she returned to college and earned a BA from Shaw University. As an early child educator, she worked for Head Start, the Coastal Center, and for the Department of Disability and Special Needs where she started the first Early Intervention program in the state. Beth was instrumental in developing the Second Chance Thrift Shop. The Wyckoffs made their last move to The Village at Summerville where they were very happy and active in resident governance and fundraising for music programs. Beth was known for her boundless energy and optimism and an amazing ability to get things done while making others feel loved and included.
