Frances Breland Welch, 99, of Walterboro, SC, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, April 30, 2024.

Family and friends are invited to a visitation on Friday, May 10, 2024, from 10:00am to 11:00am at First Baptist Church of Walterboro. A Memorial Service will be held in the sanctuary at 11:00 following the visitation. Burial will immediately follow.

Frances was born on January 6, 1925, in Walterboro, SC, a daughter of the late Mamie and Frank Breland. Frances was a very independent woman, always making sure things were up to her standard. She loved going on walks along Edisto beach and continued to do so until her later years. She graduated from Walterboro High School in the class of 1942! Afterwards, she attended Furman University where she obtained a Bachelor's degree and later earned her Master's degree from Southern Theological Seminary. Frances was a faithful member of her church, becoming the first female deacon at First Baptist Church of Walterboro. She married the love of her life; James H. Welch and they spent many years together! Frances hardly ever met a stranger. Everyone knew her from her cards that she would send, for every birthday or anniversary. Her proudest accomplishment was being a wonderful mother and grandmother to her beloved children and grandchildren. She was employed by the school district, working as a schoolteacher, until her

retirement. She was much beloved and will be greatly missed.

She is survived by her loving children: Hank Welch (Yvonne), John Welch (Mary Gail "Cissie"), and Jay Welch (Tammy); grandchildren: Justin Welch (Lindsay), Stephanie Henshaw, Joshua Welch (Krista), Baker Odom (Brandy), and Jennie Reardon (Wade).
