Frank Scrio, 57, of Summerville, husband of Diana McKissick, passed away on Monday, March 9, 2015 at the Medical University of SC.

Frank was tragically killed by a drunk driver while riding his motorcycle home from work. Frank was wearing his helmet, as he always did but was unable to recover from his internal injuries.

Frank was born in Brooklyn NY on October 23, 1957 to Rose and Sebastian Scrio. He is survived by his loving and devoted wife, Diana, four beautiful and loving daughters, Melissa, Krista, Ali, and Isabella, siblings Diana, Salvatore (Jackie), Regina (Paul), Sebastian, Jr. (Linda) and Christopher (Christine). He was a proud and loving grandfather of Randy, Jocelyn, and Amaya. He is also survived by his sister-in-law Roseanna McCarthy, and he was the beloved uncle of many nieces and nephews. Frank was blessed with many good friends too numerous to mention. He tirelessly spoke out about and in support of those who could not speak for themselves. He was a voice for good practices in his workplace, and believed that anything worth doing was worth doing well. He was the living example of a standup guy.
