George Robert Kelly Jr entered peacefully into eternal rest, after a prolonged illness, on Wednesday, January 12, 2022. He died at his daughter's home in Summerville, surrounded by family.

Born on the family homestead at Carlisle, Wyoming, March 10th, 1938, George later moved with his family to Mills, WY. He recently relocated to South Carolina for health reasons, but always considered Wyoming home. He loved the outdoors and was an avid hunter and fisherman throughout his life. George was an expert heavy equipment mechanic and worked in the mines of Wyoming.
