Glenny P. Blanchard, 85, died Wednesday, June 9, 2010 at Trident Medical Center. He was born October 9, 1924 in Denham Springs, Louisiana to Marshall P. and Ida Cormier Blanchard. He married Dorothy Nell Taylor before serving as a Private First Class in the United States Army 99th Infantry Division in World War II and specifically participating in the Battle of the Bulge. After the war, he completed his degree in Mechanical Engineering at Louisiana State University, settled in Baton Rouge, Louisiana and pursued his career in Commercial and Industrial Construction at C-B Construction Company, eventually retiring as sole owner of the company. Mr. Blanchard was a member of St. Thomas More Catholic Church and the Knights of Columbus.

He is preceded in death by his "bride" of 50 years, Nell Blanchard, his daughter, Jerri Kennedy, his brothers, Max and Charles Blanchard and his parents, Marshall and Ida Blanchard.

He is survived by two sisters, Bernice Heil and Inez Williams, a brother, Leonard Blanchard, a daughter, Donna Blanchard, a grandson, Paul Dedeaux, as well as many cousins, nieces and nephews and their families.
