Harold was born on December 24 1944 in Charleston, SC son of the late Harold L. George, Sr. and Ruth (Smith) George. He served in the Army Reserve for six years, He was a graduate of Summerville High School, Class of 1965. He attended Massey Business College in Jacksonville, FL. Harold was the owner of Mister Plumber and George's Rentals. Harold was a member of SC Coastal Seniors and Summerville Old Boys. He received a service/business award from Chamber of Commerce for Mister Plumber. He received tribute for his part of the Hire a Vet program in the 1980s. He received an award in 2005-2006 for the Spann Elementary Playground Project. He was an avid golfer and a member of Miler Country Club since 1979. He was a devoted Clemson Tiger fan but God, his wife, family and many friends came first.

He was a member of St. Luke's Lutheran Church since 1976. Harold proudly received perfect attendance in Sunday School for the year of 1979. He served

He helped formed the Friends in Christ Young Adult Group in the late 1970s and continued his service at St. Luke's in the formation of the new sanctuary.
