Harriett Stanley Dangerfield, 72, of Summerville, wife of Larry Benjamin Dangerfield passed away on Monday, August 13, 2018 at Trident Medical Center.

Harriett was born on April 1, 1946 in Conway, SC, to Willie and Albertine Stanley. She worked for thirty years as a property manager and served on the Berkeley County School Board for twelve years. With a servants heart, she worked tirelessly to serve her community and Ridge Baptist Church, where she was a member. 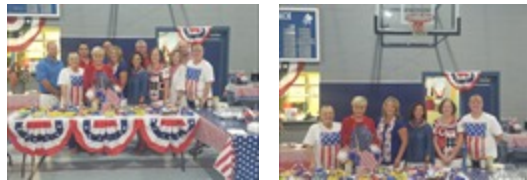
