



## Harriett Sylvia Hall

January 30, 1929 - December 8, 2022

Harriett S. Hall, 93, of Summerville, died Thursday, December 8, at the Village at Summerville. She was born on January 30, 1929, in Boston, MA, daughter of Charles Cohen and Frances Casper Cohen.

Her mother passed away when Harriett was a young teen, and her father was a “bookkeeper” who owned and operated a popular waterfront bar called the Cameo Café in Newport, R.I. After two years of college, Harriett left home and enlisted in the Navy as a WAVE. In the Navy she studied meteorology at Lakehurst, NJ, where she met and later married Loren, a fellow Navy weather student. Her promising military career came to an abrupt end with the birth of her first child, but she continued to work as a civil service employee for the military for another 35 years as her husband continued his service career. Their life as a military family took them to Japan, Okinawa, Greece, Colorado and Florida before retiring to Summerville, SC. Harriett loved to travel and her home was full of memorabilia from her life and travels abroad.

Harriett did not respond well to being officially retired so she filled up her schedule with volunteer jobs. Most notable among them was her job at the gift shop at Middleton Plantation.

She was predeceased by her husband Loren, sister, Lillian, and brother, David. She is survived by her son, Bradley Hall of Wyomissing, PA. and a daughter Janis Bennett, of Irmo, S.C. She has five grandchildren, Matthew Hall, Brian Hall, Elizabeth Hall, Cynthia Areheart, and Sylvia Bennett, as well as 6 great grandchildren.

The family would like to acknowledge and thank Harriett's caregivers for their loving care in her final years. The staffs at Always Best Care, the Village at Summerville, and Gentiva Hospice Care were a blessing and a comfort to Harriett and her family. A special thank you to Julie Walters who was her most loyal and faithful friend and was by her side until the end.
