I heard Hank cry out almost immediately. He had jumped into a pod of jellyfish. He needed help so I turned to help. I towed him about twenty yards or so till we got to shallower water and walked the rest of the way in. Hank had dark red welts on his arms and neck. We were fortunate we didn't hit anymore.
