Hermina "Minnie" Michki, 97, of Summerville, widow of Joseph Michki, passed away on Saturday, February 6, 2016 at her residence.

Minnie was born on January 13, 1919 in Roebling, NJ daughter of the late Alex and Grace (Toth) Boytos. She enjoyed cake decorating, crocheting, knitting, and cooking. She was an active lifetime member of Hungarian Lodge and a member of St. John the Beloved Catholic Church. Minnie worked at a malleable plant in Terre Haute, IN for 20 years as a core maker, leaving the plant in 1962. 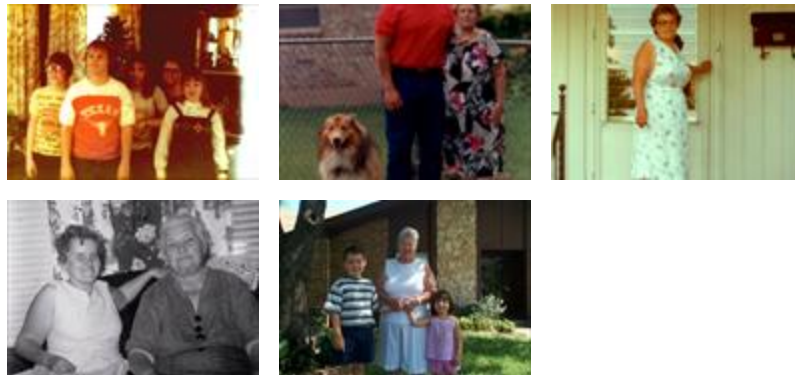
