



Inge Van de Wall Henderson

February 4, 1945 - May 20, 2026

Inge Van de Wall Henderson died peacefully in her sleep on May 20, 2026, following a brief illness. She was born February 4, 1945 outside of Bremerhaven, Germany.

She was part of the first generation of students when English became a mandatory subject. After school, it enabled her to find employment as a translator with United States Department of Defense.

While working for the DoD, she met a young and handsome Navy man who worked across the hall. They were happily married for 60 years.

Shortly after getting married, they were stationed in Edzell, Scotland, where they adopted their only child, Thomas. Inge often recalled their years in Scotland as some of her fondest.

Eventually, they made their way to the US, and settled in Summerville, South Carolina. She dedicated her time to her family as a stay at home wife and mother. She also spent a lot of time at St. Luke's, particularly tending to the numerous flower beds.

Not only did she cultivate the church gardens, she meticulously maintained her own, proudly winning neighborhood "yard of the month" numerous times.

She was predeceased by her husband, Harley, her parents, and only brother. She is survived by her son Tom (Courtney), and only grandchild Cullen.

A funeral service will be held at St. Luke's Lutheran Church on Tuesday, June 2nd at 1 pm. She will be interred at the church columbarium, and laid to rest alongside her husband.
