Jessie Colvin Stoney Mueller, born July 8, 1922, in Dillon, SC, to the late Janie Colvin and Sanford Barker Stoney, Sr. Her family moved to Summerville in 1931. She graduated from Summerville High School in 1939, thirty-nine graduates in the largest class to graduate up to that time.
