



Joseph Tullie Holleman

October 10, 1923 - February 8, 2015

Joseph Tullie Holleman, 91, of Summerville, widower of Adele McKey Holleman, passed away at The Village of Summerville, on Sunday, February 8, 2015, which would have been the 90th birthday of his beloved wife. A graveside service will be held on Saturday, February 14, 2015, at 10 o'clock AM at White Church Cemetery, Summerville. A memorial service will follow at 1 o'clock PM at The Villages of Summerville. A reception will be held immediately after the service.

Joseph was born on October 10, 1923, in Turners Station, KY, son of the late Julian Holleman and Mattie (Foree) Holleman. He graduated from the United States Naval Academy. He served in the United States Navy and retired from Polaris Missile Facility Atlantic as an ordnance engineer. He volunteered for the South Carolina Historical Society for more than 30 years; and was nationally known as a Civil War Postal Historian. He was a member of Summerville Presbyterian Church.

Surviving are: three daughters: Laurie H. Sherrod (Denny) of Pendleton, SC, Sarah H. Brown (David) of Alvin, SC and Peggy H. Williams (Robert) of St. Stephen, SC; one son: Joseph T.
