



## Joseph Richard Lindenmayer

Joseph Richard “Dick” Lindenmayer, beloved Husband, Father, Grandfather, Great Grandfather and Friend passed away on his 87th birthday in his home in Summerville, South Carolina on 31 December 2013.

Born and raised near Syracuse, NY Dick joined the Merchant Marine in 1944 and served in the North Atlantic until the end of WWII. He again served with the Army in the Korean War during 1952-53. He returned home and met Anne Klapetzky, fell in love and they were married in 1954. They raised 6 Sons and 1 Daughter in the Kuyahoorra Valley of upstate NY where Dick worked for NY State as a Cooperative Extension Agent for Herkimer County and was active in many youth & civic organizations as well as the E.W. Corey Volunteer Fire Company in Middleville, NY. They owned and operated Lindenmayer Landscapes in Herkimer 1984-99, retiring to Florida and then SC.

He lived an excellent life and is survived by his Wife, Sons, 10 Grandchildren and 1 Great Granddaughter.
