On March 9th, 2022, Larry E. Tenney passed away in Summerville, SC at the age of 75. 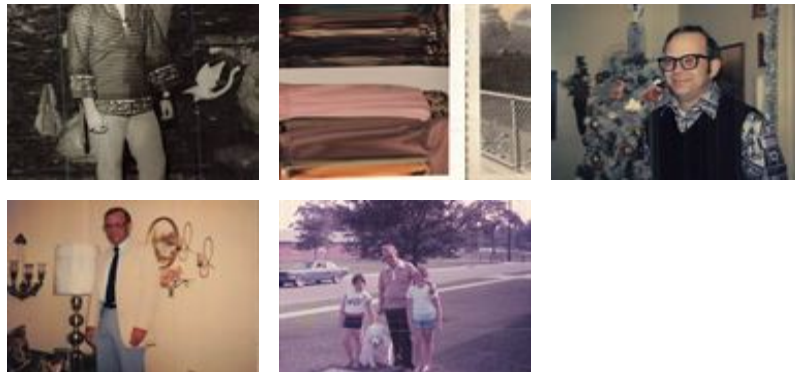

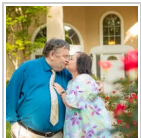

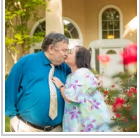
