Lawrence “Wayne” Kalinowski, 73, of Robbinsville, NJ, passed away on Tuesday, August 1, 2023 in Summerville, SC, surrounded by his loving family. Wayne was a graduate of Princeton High School. He enjoyed spending time at the farm with friends, playing cards in his barn with the guys, vacationing, and golf trips, especially with his friend, the late George Field. One of the things Wayne was the proudest of was restoring his 1935 Oldsmobile.

Wayne was a dedicated family man. He loved his family and 7 grandchildren. He loved baseball, driving on the tractor, WaWa coffee, trips to the boardwalk for Maruca’s Pizza and family vacations to South Carolina and Costa Rica.

Wayne was predeceased by his mother, Edna Kalinowski, and father-in-law,

and mother-in-law, John and Alice McGuire. Also predeceased by his aunt and uncles who were an influential part of his upbringing.
