Dr. Lori Ann Campbell, 54, of Summerville, passed away on Monday, December 2, 2019 at her residence following a long illness.

Lori was born on February 21, 1965 in Youngstown, Ohio, a daughter of the late Edward and Dorothy Bunyoff.

She leaves her husband of 29 years, Dr. Stephen Campbell of Summerville; sisters Vicki Becker (Glen) of Beaufort and Kathi Peddicord (Don) of Summerville; and many nieces and nephews. In addition to her parents she was predeceased by her brother, Gerald Bunyoff of Columbia.

Lori was a graduate of The Northeast Ohio Universities College of Medicine. She came to Summerville in 1990 and devoted her professional life to her work as an Obstetrician/Gynecologist at Women's Health Partners in Summerville which she established in 1993.

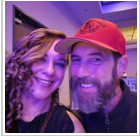
