Louie Thomas Inabinett, Sr., 90, was lifted by the arms of Jesus, to his heavenly home Wednesday, October 26, 2016 in Greenville, SC.

A graveside service and burial will be held at 2 o'clock PM, Saturday, October 29, 2016, Christ St. Paul's Episcopal Church Cemetery, Yonges Island, SC.

Louie was born on April 11, 1926 in Branchville, SC. He was the son of the late Roland Monroe Inabinett and Annie Maybell Thompson Inabinett. He was a veteran of the Korean Conflict, serving in the U.S. Army and earning the Korean Service Medal with two Bronze Service Stars, United Nations Service Medal, Combat Infantry Badge, and National Defense Service Medal. Louie went on to own L.T.I. Produce, a farming and produce shipping business, for 50 years before his retirement. "Boogie," as he was called by many family members and friends, loved the Lord, having been born and reared in the Methodist church and attended Roper Mountain Baptist Church in Greenville, SC. He was a much loved husband, father, grandfather, great grandfather, and friend. Louie will be missed for his giving spirit, strength of character, and kind heart.
