Louis "Lou" Stuart Bodony, 81, of Summerville, husband of Kathryn "Kelly" Bodony, passed away on Tuesday, March 15, 2022 at his residence.



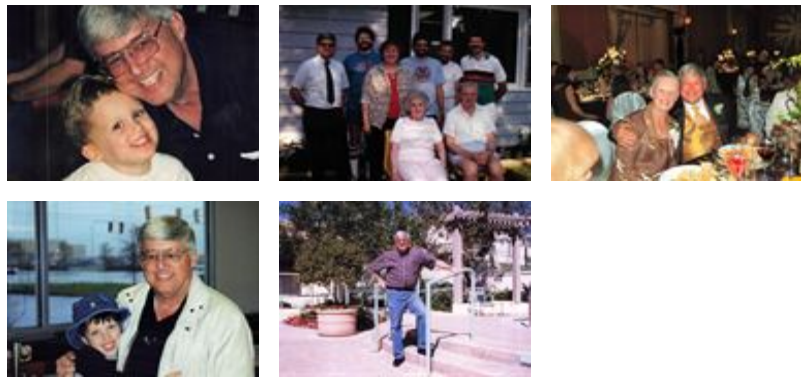

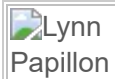
