Lunice Edward "Eddie" Hogan, 65, of Summerville, husband of Laura Whitaker Hogan, passed away on Tuesday, December 30, 2014 at Roper Hospital after a prolonged illness.

A celebration of his life will be held at James A. Dyal Funeral Home on Saturday, February 7, 2014 from 1 o'clock PM until hour of service. Memorial services will begin at 2 o'clock PM.

Eddie was born on January 3, 1949 in Columbia, SC son of the late Paul Hogan and LaVerne (Ulm) Clack. He served in the United States Army during the Vietnam Era. Eddie was a musician in Columbia for many years and in 1979 he met the love of his life Laura. They were married at Washington Street United Methodist Church in Columbia, SC on May 23, 1982. Eddie managed The Record Bar in Northwoods Mall for many years. In 1990 he founded Charleston's Free Time Newspaper and published it until his kidney disease forced him to retire.
