Lynn Livingston, 76, of Edisto Beach, wife of the late Archie Swift Livingston, passed away of a broken heart on Tuesday, April 6, 2021 at her daughter's residence.

A gathering of family and friends to celebrate Lynn and Archie's lives will be held on Saturday, April 17, 2021 from 1 o'clock to 2 o'clock at James A. Dyal Funeral Home. A memorial service will begin at 2 o'clock at James A. Dyal Funeral Home Chapel.

Lynn was born on July 11, 1944 in Greenville, SC, daughter of the late John and Osra Caligan.
