Margaret Ann " Marty " Turney, 82, of Summerville, South Carolina, passed from this life on Saturday, April 1, 2023 in Summerville. Born on July 24, 1940 in Toledo, Ohio to her parents, Harold and Mary (Zurnoch) Turney. Marty went on to serve in the Women's Army Corps for 3 years and she worked for and retired from the Bell System (now At & T). Marty served on the Board of the Dorchester County Senior Center, the Volunteer Advisory Board at Middleton, she also volunteered for many additional charitable causes and for the Democratic Party as well. Marty was of the catholic faith and she worshiped at St. John the Beloved in Summerville.

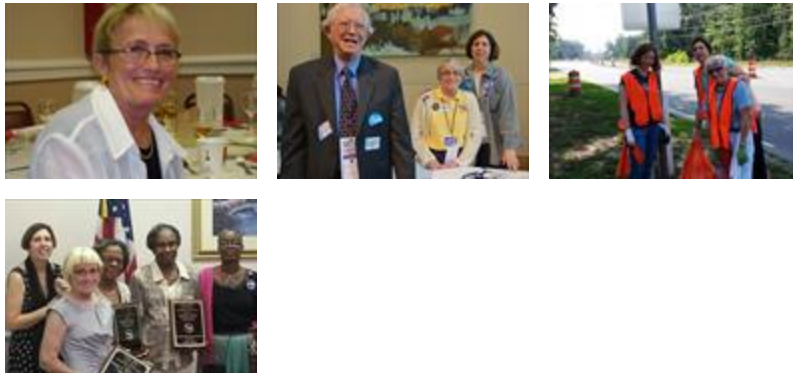
