



Marion Thomas Crider Jr.

Marion Crider, Jr. 69, of Ridgeville, husband of Mildred LaVerne Crider, passed away on Friday, May 6, 2022.

A gathering of family and friends will be held on Monday, May 9, 2022 from 10 o'clock to 2 o'clock at Trinity United Methodist Church, 1514 Hwy 61 Givhans, SC, 29472. A memorial service will begin at 2 o'clock. Mr. Crider was born on December 1, 1952 in Columbia, SC, the son of Marion and Mary Emily Crider. Marion enlisted in the U.S. Army at 14 years old, completed basic and infantry training, had orders to deport to Vietnam before age was discarded. He was honorably discharged from the U.S. Army and reenlisted with the U.S. Air Force at the age of 17. He requested to be sent to Vietnam and was sent to Korea. He was a security force K-9 Sgt. He also worked for the Town of Ehrhardt as a police officer. He reenlisted in the S.C. Army National Guard in the 70's and was selected for OCS and completed his final commission as Captain. He was a Dorchester County Sheriff's deputy and retired as the LT. over the warrants division. Mr. Crider is survived by his wife, LaVerne of 44 years; three children: Marion Thomas Crider, III (Linda) of Summerville, David Marion Crider (Kim) of Givhans, Amy Elizabeth Crider of Hampton; Eight grandchildren and three great grandchildren.

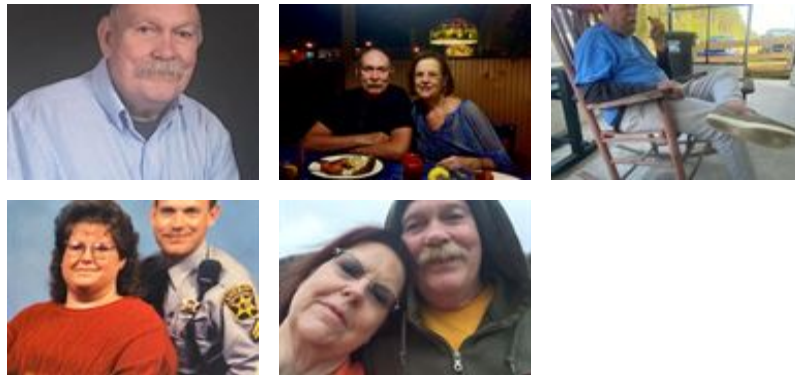
