



Marjorie Helen Philips

January 15, 1923 - March 6, 2014

Marjorie Helen Philips died Thursday March 6, 2014 at the Villages of Summerville, South Carolina at the age of 91.

She was born January 15, 1923 in Elwood, Indiana, the only child of Fay Calder and Anna Watson Snodgrass. Her family relocated to Northern Ohio when she was small and Marjorie attended local schools, graduating from Vermillion (Ohio) High School in 1940. She attended Ohio Business College and went to work at the Plum Brook Ordnance Factory in Sandusky prior to the US entry into World War II. She worked for other defense factories in Elwood and Indianapolis before moving to West Palm Beach in 1945. In 1948 she was struck with polio and spent a year recovering and in 1949 married Charles F. Philips from West Palm Beach. The Philips' had two sons, Charles Frederick, Jr. and Brian Perry and they were married for 57 years. Marjorie was very involved in several business sororities in Indiana and West Palm Beach and the Coterie Club and the Methodist Circle. In 1973, at the age of 50 she became a Christian and for forty years faithfully served the Lord. She was active in the Methodist, Evangelical Free, and Presbyterian churches in West Palm Beach and at Crossroads Baptist Church in Summerville, SC. In 1999 due to declining health the Philips's moved to North Charleston to be near one of their sons. In 2013, Marjorie moved to the Villages of Summerville, and passed away after a lengthy battle with cancer. She is survived by her two sons: Charlie Jr. (Debbie) Philips of North Charleston and Brian (Lori) Philips of Brevard, North Carolina; four

grandchildren: Laurie P. Sun (George) of Houston, Elizabeth P. Timmons (Mark) of Louisville, Kentucky, Chase S. Philips and Hunter R. Philips of Brevard; and seven great grandchildren: Ellie G. Timmons, Lydia G. Timmons, Simeon D. Timmons, Anna S. Timmons, Nathaniel A. Sun, Natalie A. Sun and Zachery A. Sun.
