Mary Elizabeth “Beth” Wren, 56, of Summerville, S.C. entered into eternal rest on Thursday, October 24th, 2024, after a long battle with cancer. Born June 6th, 1968, in Rock Hill, S.C., Beth is survived by her parents Dr. Joe Richard Wren and Kaye Patterson Wren, both of Summerville, S.C.; brother Joseph Richard Wren (Teresa) of Mount Pleasant, S.C.; sister Clary Wren Vance (Todd) of Jupiter, Florida; nephew J.J. Beth worked as a daycare assistant at Summerville Baptist Church for many years and she founded the “Buddy Club” at three different churches: Broadway Baptist in Maryville, TN; First Baptist Sevierville in Sevierville, TN; and Summerville Baptist Church in Summerville, SC. This members-only club prioritized being kind to others, encouraging one another, and attending church each week. Members were charged a dollar if they missed a Sunday, and no one wanted to be left off the exclusive friend list. Apart from working with children and ensuring church attendance, Beth enjoyed spending time with family, coloring pictures for her buddies, giving small gifts and notes to friends, and cheering on the Tennessee Vols. Beth was well-known for her bright smile, sweet spirit, and positive outlook on life. To know her was to love her.

The family will receive friends on Sunday, November 3rd at Summerville

Baptist Church from 2:00 to 3:00 p.m. and a celebration of life service will take place at 3:00 p.m. Prior to the celebration, a graveside service will take place at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, November 2nd at Midway Baptist Church in Gaffney, S.C., for family members.

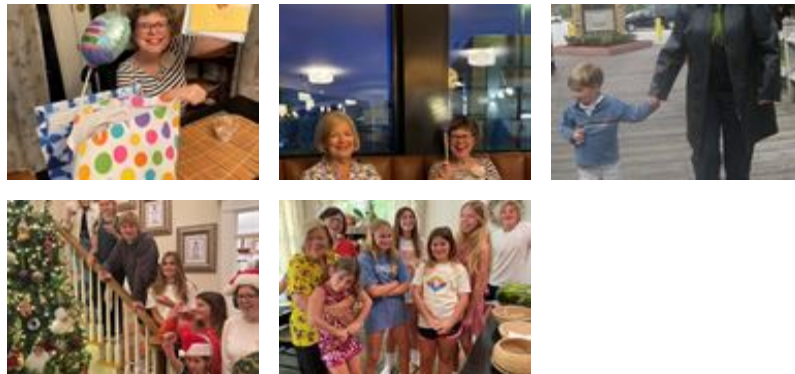
