



## McAdoo "Mackie" Pershing White

July 16, 1943 - July 30, 2020

McAdoo "Mackie" Pershing White, 77, of Summerville, husband of Martha Hugh Floyd White, passed away on Thursday, July 30, 2020 at his residence.

A gathering of family and friends will be held on Friday, August 7, 2020 from 6 o'clock to 8 o'clock at James A. Dyal Funeral Home. A memorial service will be held on Saturday, August 8, 2020 at 11 o'clock at Summerville Baptist Church, 417 Central Ave., Summerville, SC 29483.
