Gregory Douglas Sabatello, 76, of Summerville, husband of Brenda Collins Sabatello, passed away on Tuesday, November 19, 2019.

Greg was born on September 9, 1943 in Schenectady, NY, son of the late Carmen and Mary Sabatello. He was honorably discharged with 26 years of active and reserve duty from the US Army as MSGT. Greg was a combat veteran in Vietnam.

Survivors in addition to his wife Brenda of 41 years are three children: Faith Sharkey, William Glazier, II, and Cristine Glazier, all of Summerville; four granddaughters: Angel Stech (Nicholas) of Portland, OR, , Victoria Derrick (John) of Lexington, SC, Miranda Woodham (Patrick) of Westerville, OH, and Erin Graham (David) of Fort Myers, FL; five great grandchildren: Arwyn, Padme, Patrick, Ella, and Caroline; and one sister: Rebecca Caracappa (Vito) of Newtown Square, PA.

He was an ardent patriot, a faithful Catholic, a

wonderful and loving husband, dad, grandfather, and friend. Greg was well respected and loved by many. He loved working in the garden, and he never met a dog that did not love him.
