Initially planted well over 3000 flowering bulbs and ornamentals and placed feeding stations and nest boxes for native and migratory birds. It is now a beautiful woodland park.

No visitation or memorial service is planned at the request of the deceased. A gathering of family and friends at her farm will be held at a later date. Burial will be private and conducted by James A. Dyal.
