



Norman "Norm" Hanna

June 13, 1947 - February 1, 2018

Norman (Norm) William Hanna, II of Summerville, husband of Eloise (Lise) Pickard Hanna, died February 1, 2018 at Trident Medical Center with his family at his side.

Norm was born on June 13, 1947 in Bronxville, NY, son of the late Norman W. Hanna and Janet Kohnle Hanna. A graduate of Hobart College in Geneva, NY, Norm enjoyed two careers: first proudly serving as a US naval officer and then as a home renovation contractor. He loved music and often played the piano with style and gusto. He also was an excellent drummer for which he attended Julliard. A great wit, Norm had a gift for storytelling.

Norm and Lise settled in Summerville in 1980 and both their children graduated from Summerville High School. Norm was a longtime member of the Summerville Oakbrook Rotary Club.

Survivors in addition to Lise, his wife of 47 years, include: one daughter, Stephanie H. Davis (Steven) of James Island; one son, Zachary T. Hanna (Katy) of Charleston; five grandchildren: Addie, Harper, and Emmy Collins Hanna; Sarah and Cole Davis; one sister, Virginia Bell (Bill) of Orlando, FL and several nieces and nephews.

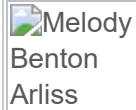
